

Mrs. Hundrup's 2016-2017 Supplies List

- 3 Composition Notebooks (not spiraled please)
 - Math – **Graph Paper** (helps with keeping place value)
 - Journal – Wide Ruled
 - Language Arts – Wide Ruled
- Post it – place holders for composition notebooks
- 1 inch binder
- 5-subject dividers for binder
 - Labeled
 - Math
 - Language Arts
 - Cultural Studies
 - Science
 - Paper
- Paper – in the binder (be prepared to resupply)
- 1 Folder (Preferably plastic, it will be used to bring materials to and from home)
- White Erase Markers
- Pencils
- Red Pens
- 1 box of Colored Pencils
- Pencil box or pouch
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Erasers
- Highlighters (1 yellow, 1 green, 1 pink)
- Milk Crate (a sturdy one as this will be used for seating throughout the year)
- Back Pack
- Clorox wipes
- Tissues
- Non marking sneakers to be kept at school – winter boots are bulky to wear in the classroom, they can also be worn for gym.
- \$6 for miscellaneous supplies used throughout the year (such as cooking, crafting, glue, graph paper, etc.)

Please make sure to label **ALL** of your child's supplies and clothing that will be used or worn at school. Remember that you'll be shopping the same sales, so items can easily be confused for someone else's if misplaced.

All of the school supplies will need to fit within your child's milk crate. I'll have a place for binders and notebooks on shelves. With 28 bodies and limited space, I'll be reducing furniture in the classroom to make it feel more comfortable and roomy. The milk crates will allow children to move about the room with their supplies and will also stack nicely at the end of each day. I'll provide a board that serve as a dual purpose to provide a seating surface and enclose their belongings.
