I keep class supplies of the following:

Rulers, protractors, compasses, scissors, colored pencils, markers for language work, and red checking pencils and pens. You may want to have your own sets of these. If so, please mark with your name. I also have composition books and math notebooks.

Students need to bring:

- 12 sharpened #2 pencils - label 1 package for yourself and one for class
- You may use mechanical pencils if you take care of them and remember to continue getting your own lead.
- 12 or 24 colored pencils - labeled
- 2-3 packages of lined paper - wide-lined for 4th and 5th. Narrow 6th depending on large or small handwriting. **Please get paper that is 10 ½ by 8 inches, not the 11 inch paper.
- 1 simple 1 ½ three ring binder—Use last years. **Please no trapper keepers with many pockets.**
- 1 standard pencil box or zipper pouch
- 1 **stiff or sturdy pocket folder for homework**—stiff plastic works well
- Gym shoes or sneakers—for PE and inside use instead of boots all day. Tie or Velcro on, safe to run or jump in, and won't make black marks.
- Backpack or book bag
- 1 rectangular box of tissues
- \$6 for craft supplies and materials, and special graphing, art, and writing materials.
- (If you need to get just some of these supplies now and the rest later on, be sure to get the paper, some pencils, dividers, and binder now. Beginning of school prices won't last. Please let me know if you need assistance.)

- Mr. Stafford requests **Let's Play Recorder, Vol. One.** Last year's works. He also recommends Vol. Two.

PLEASE MARK EVERYTHING WITH PERMANENT MARKER: Lunchboxes and containers, Shoes, Book Bag, Jackets, Folder, Notebooks, Colored pencils, Scissors, Pencil Box, Individual Colored pencils, and Plastic on packages of paper.

Also Useful: Students will need a dictionary at home for homework. 6th graders and some 5th will need a dictionary that gives at least the part of speech, and word origins, Also useful—an up to date student atlas.
